DAY 1 -

Give each parent the mind of Christ in training up their children in the way they should go, and when they are old they will not turn from it. Help fathers to not provoke their children to anger, but to bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord. **Proverbs 22:6; Ephesians 6:4**

We pray that parents will love each other, live by the Spirit and be led by the Spirit, daily bearing the fruit of the Spirit which is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, fidelity, gentleness and self-control. **Galatians 5:14-22**

May the peace of Christ rule in each parent's heart, and the Word of Christ richly dwell within, them so that with all wisdom they may teach their children diligently at all times, under all circumstances, with joy and thankfulness in their heart. **Colossians 3:15-16; Deuteronomy 6:4-9**

May no unwholesome word proceed from each parent's mouth, but only such a word as is good for edification according to the need of the moment, that it may give grace to those who hear. **Ephesians 4:29**

DAY 3 –

OUR CHURCH

We pray for each member of our church: That our whole church body be knit and joined together with every one being an active part and doing their share, causing growth to the body. **Ephesians 4:16**

That there not be among us man, woman or family whose heart turns away from God; that there may not be among us any root bearing bitterness; that no one would deceive themselves in their heart by saying, *"I shall have peace even though I follow the dictates of my heart."* **Deuteronomy 29:18**

That in our church unity will prevail because we are built upon a strong foundation in Jesus Christ. **Ephesians 2:20-22**

That each member of our church receives revelation of the mystery of the Gospel when our pastor speaks, and that they will be able to understand how they fit into the body of Christ. **Ephesians 3:2-4,7**

That our faith would not fail and each member would not grow weary in well doing, but be filled with boldness to go out in the highways and byways and compel the lost to come in. **Luke 22:32**

Fill each member with the Holy Spirit that we might all know the things that have been freely given to us by God and be empowered to be bold witnesses to our communities. **1 Corinthians 2:12; Acts 1:8**

We put a hedge of protection around our church – every department, every outreach ministry, and each team member – against every fiery dart of Satan. By the Blood of the Lamb and the word of our testimony we overcome the devil. **Revelation 12:11**

That God will give us favor with our communities and add to the church daily those who are being saved. **Acts 2:47**

DAY 4 -

GOVERNMENT - FEDERAL, STATE, LOCAL

We pray that the eyes of our leaders' hearts will be enlightened that they might know the truth and lead this nation in righteousness.

Ephesians 1:18

We lift up our government to You, praying for all men and women who have authority over us, that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty. **1 Timothy 2:1-2**

We pray that our leaders will listen to You and receive correction. Pour out Your Spirit upon them and make Your Word known to them.

Proverbs 1:23, 33

Bring the counsel of the wicked to nothing and make the plans of the people of no effect. **Psalms 33:10**

Raise up Godly counselors to advise our President and other officials. **Proverbs 11:14; Isaiah 28:29**

Raise up leaders among us who long for Your judgments at all times, who delight in Your ways, keep your statutes, seek Your counsel and choose the way of truth. Keep them from deceitful ways. Remove from them scorn and contempt. Though rulers sit together and slander them, strengthen our leaders to meditate on and follow Your decrees. May Your statutes be their delight and counsel every day. **Psalms 119:20-35**

We pray that all those whose hearts are hard and who refuse to look to You for wisdom be removed from positions of authority and influence; that men and women who will revere and listen to your voice be placed in positions of authority in our nation. He who rules over men must be just, ruling in the fear of God.

1 Samuel 23:3

Bring to light what is hidden in darkness and expose the purposes of the heart. **1 Corinthians 4:5**

We pray that our President will acknowledge You, fear Your name and abide in You. May mercy and truth preserve and guard him and may he sing praise to Your name, O God. May his soul find rest in God alone and he find salvation in Christ. **Isaiah 48:17; Psalms 62**

DAY 17 -

THOSE IN PRISON

I thank you that you the Lord hears the needy and does not despise his own people who are prisoners.

Psalms 69:33

God, we know that you love the prisoners and the addicted and the homeless, for it is written, *"See, I have written your name on the palms of My hands."* **Isaiah 49:16**

Lord we remember those who are in prison, as though in prison with them, and those who are mistreated, since you also are in the body.

Hebrews 13:3

Lord we pray: *"Let the groans of the prisoners come before you; according to your great power, preserve those doomed to die!"*

Psalms 79:11; Psalms 102:18-21

We pray that the prisoners and those in bondage would repent. *"As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: be zealous therefore, and repent."* **Revelation 3:19**

We pray that as each one is set free that they would learn to cast their cares on The Lord. *"Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time: Casting all your care upon Him; for He cares for you."* **1 Peter 5:6-7**

That each one would live free of condemnation. *"And, having made peace through the blood of His cross, by Him to reconcile all things unto Himself."* **Colossians 1:20**

They would learn where their strength and protection come from. *"The name of the LORD is a strong tower: the righteous runs into it, and is safe."* **Proverbs 18:10**

We pray that they would never be caught in sin and addiction again. *"Stand fast therefore in the liberty where with Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage."*

Galatians 5:1

DAY 16 –

OUR PASTORS AND LEADERS

That God will give His angels charge over them, to keep them in all of their ways. That the Holy Spirit's passion for God's TRUTH will saturate them and come forth through their words as they minister.

That daily God will open up doors for the Word so that they may clearly present the mystery of Christ. **Colossians 4:3**

I thank you for Your Spirit which is upon, _____, anointing him/her to preach the gospel to the poor, to proclaim release to the captives, recovery of sight to the blind and to set free those who are downtrodden. **Luke 4:18**

That they will proclaim the gospel message, persist in it whether convenient or not, and rebuke, correct and encourage with great patience.

That they will not turn away from the truth, but keep a clear head about everything, endure hardship and do the work fulfilling the ministry to which they are called. **2 Timothy 4:1-5**

That they would speak in words which the Holy Spirit teaches, not in man's wisdom, since the world through its wisdom does not know God. **1 Corinthians 2:13**

That the preaching and everyday speech be in demonstration of the Spirit and of power, that people's faith would not rest on the wisdom of men, but on the power of God. **1 Corinthians 2:4**

Lord, grant that _____ may speak Your word with all confidence while You extend Your hand to heal, and signs and wonders take place through the name of Your holy servant Jesus. **Acts 4:29-30**

That _____ will boldly share the gospel not in Word only, but also in power and in the Holy Spirit with full conviction; that they may speak not as pleasing men, but God, who examines each of our hearts. **1 Thessalonians 1:5; 2:4**

Cause his/her speech to be soft and able to break down the most bone-like resistance in dealing with difficult people and situations. **Proverbs 25:15**

DAY 5 –

NEIGHBORS, CO-WORKERS, CLASSMATES

I pray that You direct their hearts into the love of God and the steadfastness of Christ. **2 Thessalonians 3:5**

I pray that the word of the Lord will spread rapidly and be honored in our schools, work places and among our neighbors. May people look to You and be saved, for You are God and there is no other. **Isaiah 45:22**

Help me to live in such a way that I can be a light to those I come in contact with. Help me to love people in such a way that they are drawn to Jesus.

Move through our neighborhood by Your Spirit, bringing hope, healing and blessing.

Grant them eyes to see, ears to hear, and a tender, receptive heart to understand and receive Your provision of salvation, of deliverance, healing, forgiveness, well-being, direction and provision for their needs and for every good work. **Matthew 13**

That a biblical world view would be taught in schools.

That God would be honored, the Word of God studied, and praying to have God restored in our schools.

DAY 6 -

FAMILY

Thank You, Lord, that we can confidently come into Your presence with thanksgiving! And this is the confidence we have before You, that if we ask anything according to Your will, You hear us, and if we know that You hear us in whatever we are asking, we know that we have the requests which we have asked from You. **1 John 5:14**

We lift up our children to You asking that You grant them according to the riches of Your glory to be strengthened with power through Your Spirit in their inner man, so that Christ may dwell in each of their hearts through faith and they will be rooted and grounded in the love of Christ. **Ephesians 3:16-19**

That they seek out and nurture Godly friendships. **Psalms 1:1-3**

That they have thankful and teachable spirits. **Romans 1:21**

That they be generous and have compassionate hearts for the poor and needy. **Psalms 112:9; Luke 10:33-37**

That they redeem their time and know priorities. **Ephesians 5:15-17**

DAY 7 -

DAY 12 -

YOUTH

Hope - Help today's teen take every thought captive for Christ. Fill every young person with the hope of the resurrection of Jesus Christ, and protect their mind and heart from hopelessness. Help them to cling to Christ during discouragement and soak up His strength when offering this same hope to others. **Galatians 6:9; Ephesians 6:13; Philippians 4:8; 2 Timothy 2:13; Hebrews 10:23; 1 Peter 5:8-9**

Purpose - Reveal to our young people the plans and purposes You have for them. **Jeremiah 29:11; Jeremiah 1:5; Psalm 139:13-16; 2 Corinthians 5:20; John 14:13; Romans 8:28-29**

Friendships - Give today's teenagers wisdom in choosing their friends. Bring people into their lives who will point them to Christ. **1 Corinthians 15:33; Hebrews 10:25; 1 Thessalonians 5:11; 1 Samuel 16:7**

Character - That this generation of students may experience an ongoing transformation by having their minds renewed with the Word of God. That they will be examples to the world in their speech, lives, love, faith and purity. **1 Timothy 4:12; Romans 12:1-2; Psalm 24:4**

Purity - Give our students an all consuming hunger for righteousness. Grace to say no to sin and to flee sexual immorality. That they would see clearly the rewards of preserving the gift of sex for marriage. **John 8:32; 1 Peter 1:5; Hebrews 13:4; 1 Corinthians 6:18; 1 John 4:4; James 1:12-14**

Passion - Grant this generation of teenagers an anointing of the power by the Holy Spirit and to be the greatest witnesses for Christ Jesus that we've ever known. That their zeal for obedience would supersede any other human desire that they have. **Acts 1:8; Luke 4:18-19; 1 Peter 3:15; Matthew 28:19-20; Galatians 5:24**

Submission and Honor - That this generation would submit to Christ and to those in authority over them. May He give them grace to love, respect and honor their parents, teachers, spiritual leaders and governing officials. **Ephesians 6:2-3; Hebrews 13:17; Mark 12:17**

DAY 9 -

MARRIAGES

We pray for the married couples, that they will *"Pursue the things which make for peace and the building up of one another."*
Romans 14:19

Help them to put their spouse's needs ahead of their own.
Philippians 2

That they might have hope through perseverance and encouragement of the scriptures. **Romans 15:4**

May the God of hope fill them with all joy and peace in believing, that they may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.
Romans 15:13

That the love of God be poured out within their hearts through the Holy Spirit who was given to them. For while they were still helpless, at the right time Christ died for them. **Romans 5:5-6**

Now may the God who gives perseverance and encouragement grant you to be of the same mind with one another according to Christ Jesus; that with one accord they may with one voice glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ!
Romans 15:5

That they would accept one another just as Christ also accepted them, to the glory of God. **Romans 15:7**

That they would rejoice, be made complete, be like minded and live in peace. **2 Corinthians 13:11**

May the Lord cause them to increase and abound in love for one another, so that He may establish their hearts blameless in holiness before our God and Father. **1 Thessalonians 3:12**

May the Lord direct their hearts into the love of God and into the steadfastness of Christ. **1 Thessalonians 3:5**

That both of their hearts will be granted repentance and the grace to give and receive forgiveness and be freed from hardness of heart. That they be delivered from the deceitful traps of the enemy. And be granted understanding and insight into their spouses needs and perspective. **2 Timothy 2:25-26; Ephesians 4:32**

DAY 10 –

ALL MISSIONARIES

Thank You for their work and labor of love. **Hebrews 6:10**

Stand with them and strengthen them so that the message might be preached fully through them and all might hear. Deliver them from every evil work and preserve them.

We ask You, the Lord of the harvest, to send out workers into the harvest field and meet their daily needs. **Luke 10:2-7**

We ask You, who through the blood of the eternal covenant brought back from the dead that great Shepherd of the sheep, our Lord Jesus, to equip Your servants with every good thing for doing Your will, working in them what is pleasing to You through Jesus Christ.

Open peoples' hearts to respond to the gospel.

Protect your servants by the power of Your name. Sanctify them by Your word.
